The regularly scheduled meeting of the Bristow City Council was called to order in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building at 7:00 P.M. A roll call was had with the following members present. Motion was made by Carter with a second by Groom approving Minutes of the September 17, 2012 Meeting. Motion passed.

Motion was made by Spencer with a second by Smith approving to close Main Street on October 12, 2012 from 12th street to 7th Street from 2:30 p.m. to 3:15 p.m. for the Homecoming Parade.
