SPECIAL MINUTES

The Special meeting of the Bristow City Council was called to order in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building at 12:00 P.M. A roll call was had with the following members present. Mayor Ralph Barnett. Councilmember: Deloris Carter, Frank Groom, Darold Ritchie, Edgar Spencer and Leonard Washington. Absent: Councilman Bob Edwards, Tex Slyman and Leon Smith.

Councilman Bob Edwards was present from this time forth.

Mark McGuire, Engineer from McGuire Brothers was present to speak to the Council about the bid submitted. Layne Christensen Co. was the only bidder. Mr. McGuire advised the Council that he had talked to Mr. Christensen about the bid. They have come up with several items that could be reduced or omitted completely. Mr. McGuire told the Council that once the bid is awarded, there would be a change order coming back to Council for approval. This is to make the bid lower. His bid was submitted for Base Bid & Alternative Bid #1 in the amount of \$681,817.00 for the following:
